For June 2015 we swing the spotlight over to the “McEntire - Weaver Funeral Home” in Knox located at 504 East Penn Avenue. This funeral home was built in 1989 by Dave McEntire and was originally called “The David C. McEntire Funeral Home Inc.”

Located in the center of downtown Knox, the property location has some great Knox history. It was the original site of the “Clarion County Machine Company” back in the late 1800’s and went on to become the “Slicker Pipe & Tool Company” in the 1900’s, both of these businesses were legendary in supplying the local oil field industry back in the day.

David C. McEntire opened the funeral home @ 504 East Penn Avenue in 1990 and operated it till he sadly passed away in April of 2012. Dave was a great guy, loved by all in our community and across the area. He was a huge supporter of Clarion County and it’s history having many business ties in the area. We all miss Dave.....

After Dave’s untimely passing in April 2012, Jon Weaver and his wife Holly purchased the “David C McEntire Funeral Home Inc.” and began ownership & operation of the home. It was at that time Jon & Holly renamed the business “McEntire – Weaver Funeral Home”

Jon Weaver was born on Knox Horsethief Day Saturday August 21, 1976, the son of Chuck & Lori Weaver & Kathy Weaver. Jon grew up in the Nineveh area, graduating from Keystone High School in 1994. Jon went on to school at the Pennsylvania College of Technology where he learned CAD (computer aided drafting & design) and went on to work at “Witherup Fabrication” near Clintonville Pa, applying the skills

he learned at college. It was during this time of employment in the Clintonville area that Jon met Holly McKinley, who was from Clintonville, and the rest (as they say) is history. Jon married Holly in September of 2006 and are now proud parents of a son "McKinley" who will be 8 years old in September, and a daughter "Vivian" who will be celebrating her first birthday in August.

Jon started working for Dave McEntire in 2009 and went on to graduate from Pittsburgh Institute of Mortuary Science in 2011. Jon and Holly work together well as she also has much history in the funeral business. Holly has been running the "McKinley Funeral Home" in Clintonville since 2003. Jon & Holly are in the process of combining the two businesses together at the present time.

Holly (McKinley) Weaver graduated from Franklin High School in 1996, she then went to the "Dubois Business College" graduating in 2000, and went on to school at the "Pittsburgh Institute of Mortuary Science" graduating in 2002.
